ORDER

Diamond Antenna & Microwave Corporation (“Diamond”) filed this Bid Protest with the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) of a single source award by the FAA Aeronautical Center to Kevlin Corporation. The award was for the supply of a spare part, i.e. a rotary coupler for Air Traffic Control radar. Pursuant to a Delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator, I adopt and incorporate herein the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendations and deny the Protest in its entirety.¹

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. Any review of this Order shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.33, within sixty (60) days of service of this Order.
