SUBJECT: Separation of VFR Aircraft Practicing Instrument Approaches

CANCELLATION: July 10, 2010

Sioux City Approach Control provides practice instrument approaches to VFR aircraft at the following locations:

Le Mars, IA (LRJ)
Mapleton, IA (MEY)
Vermillion, SD (VMR)
Wayne, NE (LCG)
Sioux Gateway Airport (SUX)

IFR separation will be provided between known VFR aircraft practicing instrument approaches and other known VFR practicing instrument approaches and IFR aircraft. A detailed explanation of ATC handling of practice instrument approaches is contained in the Aeronautical Information Manual.

Pilots should be aware that some airports prohibit or restrict practice approaches due to noise abatement programs or traffic congestion. This information is published in the Airport/Facility Directory, Notices to Airmen, and other documents issued by the airport sponsors.
