

TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION

The FAA Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (ODRA), under [Delegation dated December 23, 2003](#), has been called upon to provide dispute resolution services to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, [Transportation Security Administration \(TSA\)](#) in connection with designated TSA-related bid protests and contract disputes. (The December 23, 2003 delegation superseded an earlier [Delegation dated September 16, 2002](#).) Pursuant to language of the [Aviation and Transportation Security Act, Public Law 107-71](#), the FAA [Acquisition Management System \(AMS\)](#) applies to TSA acquisitions of equipment, supplies and materials. Under that statute, the AMS may be modified for use by TSA, as considered appropriate.
