The licensee shall at all times conduct its operations in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Office of Commercial Space Transportation for the activities authorized by this license.



LICENSE ORDER REGARDING OPERATION OF A
LAUNCH SITE

AUTHORIZED BY LICENSE NO. LSO 09-012
ISSUED TO

Jacksonville Aviation Authority

1. Authority: This Order is issued to Jacksonville Aviation Authority (referred to as JAA) under 49 U.S.C. Subtitle IX, Chapter 701, §§70101-70121 (Chapter 701), and the Commercial Space Transportation Licensing Regulations, 14 C.F.R. Ch. III (Regulations).
2. Purpose: This Order modifies License No. LSO 09-012 issued concurrently by the Federal Aviation Administration's Office of Commercial Space Transportation (FAA/AST), authorizing JAA to operate certain portions of Cecil Field as a launch site at Jacksonville, Florida, and prescribes as conditions to License No. LSO 09-012 certain additional requirements applicable to the authorization to operate a launch site at Cecil Field.
3. Authorization: JAA is authorized to operate a launch site at Cecil Field supporting suborbital reusable launch vehicle missions authorized by an FAA license to take-off at Cecil Field. The portions of Cecil Field that comprise the launch site are the runway 18L/36R, liquid fuel storage and loading areas, and other buildings surrounded by the public access fence line shown in green in JAA's Explosive Site Plan dated December 10, 2008.
4. All vehicles, aircraft, and persons not participating in activities licensed or permitted under Chapter 701 must be separated from launch vehicle ground operations at a distance equal to public area distance of DOD 6055.9-STD.

5. License Term: The term of License No. LSO 09-012 authorizing JAA to operate a launch site at Cecil Field is five (5) years from January 11, 2010.
