



## Air Traffic Representatives

Air Traffic Representatives are liaisons and technical advisors between the ATO and the Department of Defense (DoD). Typical activities include DoD facility inspections, airspace requirements and evaluations, air traffic control (ATC) procedure reviews, control tower operator exam administration, and certificate and rating issuance.

## Airspace Management Procedures

Airspace Management Procedures Specialists support procedures associated with the development, management, and improvement of the NAS, including civilian and military use. Specialists are equipped to deliver air traffic technical expertise through activities ranging from initial airspace designs to environmental impact, final charting, and associated procedures that govern the airspace.

## Special Events

Special Events Specialists are the planning and support arm of the System Support Group. These specialists provide responses to requests from the flying public, coordinate events that affect the NAS, and communicate notices about the airspace to the flying public.

## Mission

We provide oversight and support for National Airspace System (NAS) procedures, changes affecting operations, effectiveness and efficiency, and special activities within the NAS for ATO Service Units and other FAA organizations, as requested, to align with and support the FAA NAS.
