
ANCHORAGE AIRPORT TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 07-03

SUBJECT: Taxi Into Position and Hold Operations

CANCELLATION: December 1, 2009

TAXI INTO POSITION AND HOLD (TIPH) procedures are a tool used by air traffic control to expedite the movement of aircraft on an airport. TIPH is normally not authorized for intersection departures between the hours of sunset and sunrise. Anchorage Tower is authorized to conduct TIPH operations at the intersection of Runway 32 at Taxiway Kilo between the hours of sunset and sunrise. The following special provisions apply:

1. The intersection must be visible from the tower.
2. Runway 32 must be used as a departure-only runway.
3. Only one aircraft at a time is permitted to taxi into position and hold on the same runway.
