Subject: Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Training Opportunity

This year we are excited to announce we will be expanding opportunities during our 27th Annual Great Lakes Region Airports Conference to include live fire training at the Chicago O'Hare International Airport Fire Training Facility. This fire training will be geared for those airport firefighters that have already received (as a minimum) their initial ARFF training, but are looking to meet the annual live burn requirement outlined in 14 CFR Part 139.319(i)(3). The training will begin immediately following the end of the conference on Thursday, November 3rd. We have an exciting three day conference planned for November 1st—3rd; however, those who can only attend the Thursday sessions will be given an opportunity to register at a reduced one day, Thursday only conference rate. Conference information and registration is contained at the link below. The City of Chicago will open this training facility to a maximum of 40 attendees, so reserve early as space is limited.
