





# Reimbursable Process

- **The Lead Planner is the point of contact for the customer**
- **Lead Planner will set up the agreement**
- **Lead Planner work with internal FAA organizations**
- **Lead Planner will close out the agreement when completed**



# Airport Strategic Profiles

- **Purpose:**
  - Improve horizontal integration at WSA airports.
  - Provide a quick reference for airport operational characteristics.
- **Locations:**
  - Prioritized by airport operations and FAA activity level.
- **Content:**
  - Airport relationship to other air terminals
  - Airport Layout and Features
  - Aircraft Activity
  - Climatology
  - Air Traffic Operations
  - Accidents, Operational Errors
  - Profiles to be updated quarterly

- **Need to provide an actual operating tower**
- **Tower needs to meet FAA standard**
