Dear Industry Representative:

We are circulating Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5070-6B Change 2, Airport Master Plans, with you and other interested industry associations to obtain comments on the proposed changes. Please provide rationale for all comments and recommended modifications. All comments will be considered before we finalize and issue the proposed change.

As you are aware, this AC provides guidance for the preparation of master plans for airports that range in size and function from small general aviation to large commercial service facilities. Change 2 incorporates additional guidance on passenger convenience, ground access, and access to airport facilities, as identified in Section 131 of Public Law 112-95, the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012. It also includes limited editorial and text revisions since the release of Change 1 to this Advisory Circular (AC) in 2007. The primary revisions are contained in Chapter 8 and Appendix B of this AC.
