SUBJ: Area Forecast (FA) Schedule

- 1. Purpose of This Notice. This notice amends Paragraph 9-5-2, AREA FORECAST (FA) SCHEDULE, in Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Order JO 7110.10, Flight Services. This change is proposed in response to National Weather Service (NWS) Technical Implementation Notice 13-21. The paragraph will now state that the Alaska Area Forecasts will be issued three times a day effective November 12, 2013. Concurrently, Table 9-5-2 will be updated to reflect the new issuance times for NWS Alaska Area Forecasts.
- **2. Audience**. This notice applies to the following Air Traffic Organization (ATO) service units: En Route and Oceanic, Terminal, Mission Support, System Operations and Flight Services, Department of Defense (DOD) facilities, where applicable, and all other associated air traffic control facilities.
- **3.** Where Can I Find This Notice? This notice is available on the MyFAA employee Web site at https://employees.faa.gov/tools_resources/orders_notices/ and on the air traffic publications Web site at http://www.faa.gov/air_traffic/publications/.
- **4. Procedures.** Amend FAA Order JO 7110.10, paragraph 9–5–2 and TABLE 9-7-1, to read as follows:

9-5-2. AREA FORECAST (FA) SCHEDULE

FAs are issued three times a day in the contiguous U.S., <u>Alaska and the Gulf of Mexico and four times a day in</u> Hawaii, and the Caribbean. The issuance times are in TBL 9-5-2.
