## SUBJ: AIR TRAFFIC PLANNED MEETINGS/CONFERENCES (RIS: AT 1210-1)

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. This order establishes a system to identify upcoming meetings and conferences scheduled by Washington offices/services and regional meetings at which attendance by air traffic managers is desired. It will also identify industry meetings/conferences which are of interest to air traffic managers.
- 2. <u>DISTRIBUTION</u>. This order is distributed to regional administrators and center directors, division level in Washington offices and services, branch level in Washington and regional air traffic offices, and the FAA Academy.
- 3. <u>BACKGROUND</u>. In an effort to keep air traffic management officials apprised of upcoming meetings/conferences which may be of interest to them and to assist the air traffic complex in its planning efforts, a system for reporting meetings and conferences is needed. This system will identify those meetings and conferences at which attendance by air traffic management officials is desired.
- 4. AIR TRAFFIC PLANNED MEETINGS/CONFERENCES (RIS: AT 1210-1).
- a. Offices scheduling meetings/conferences requiring participation by Washington air traffic division managers and above, or regional air traffic division managers are requested to advise the Executive Staff, AAT-10, ATTN: Administrative and Management Support Branch, AAT-13, of the dates, location, subject of meeting/conference (spell out all abbreviations), attendees, meeting contact point, routing symbol and telephone number. Also include any planned attendance at industry-sponsored meetings/conferences.
- b. This report is due 15 days prior to the end of each quarter. We encourage the identification of meetings/conferences planned beyond the 3-month timeframe even if specific dates/locations are not yet known.
- c. In order to assure the timely release of this information, we will assume a negative response if reports are not received by the due date.
- d. AAT-10 will submit a quarterly listing of meetings/conferences to all air traffic offices. If there are any corrections or additions to the quarterly listing, changes may be phoned in to AAT-13 on FTS 267-9115.
