This memo is to request cancellation of Order 1110.145, Certificated Design Organization (CDO) Aviation Rulemaking Committee.

The CDO Aviation Rulemaking Committee (ARC) was established with the release of Order 1110.145 on May 22, 2006. The committee was to remain in existence until May 22, 2008, unless extended. The ARC completed its work and issued its recommendations in May 2008, making the order no longer necessary.

No other line of business (LOB), region, or center organization has further need for this directive. It has been removed from the active file in the Regulatory and Guidance Library (RGL).

Accordingly, we ask that Order 1110.145 be officially cancelled.
