


Airway Transportation Systems Specialist/Electronics Technician

Install, maintain, repair and certify radar, communications, computers, navigational aids, airport lighting aids and other electrical/mechanical equipment to assure a reliable, safe and smooth flow of air traffic. Design, develop and evaluate new types of electronic equipment, lighting aids and environmental support equipment for the air traffic systems. Maintain power, heating, air conditioning and electronic equipment within air traffic control facilities. Work is performed at airports and other FAA facilities as well as outdoors in open fields and even on remote mountain tops. Significant travel is required throughout New England states. Most positions involve rotating shifts and weekend work.

Qualification Requirements

- ➔ Experience as a technician, instructor, inspector or mechanic (civilian or military) that demonstrates progression in knowledge of electronic theory and a variety of types of electronics systems/equipment, power systems or heating and air conditioning systems. Experience must include the use of schematic diagrams, varieties of test equipment and application of appropriate formulas in such functions as testing, troubleshooting, repairing and calibrating.
- ➔ Related experience that provides basic knowledge of the principles of electronics, math, computers or related areas may also be qualifying.
- ➔ In some positions, usable vision, hearing and speech may be required as well as ability to lift and carry objects of about 20 to 50 pounds, climb ladders and/or work in unusual or uncomfortable environmental conditions.
- ➔ Must be a United States citizen. Must pass a pre-employment drug test.
