

AVIATION SAFETY INSPECTORS (MANUFACTURING)



Aviation Safety Inspectors (Manufacturing):

Aviation Safety Inspectors (Manufacturing) administer and enforce safety regulations and standards for the production and/or modification of air carrier and general aviation aircraft. Some of their duties are to:

- ➔ Inspect prototype or modified aircraft, aircraft parts and avionics equipment for conformity with design specifications and safety standards;
- ➔ Assume FAA certificate responsibility for assigned manufacturing facilities, which includes evaluation/surveillance of both production operations and quality control operations; and
- ➔ Make original airworthiness determinations and issue certificates for all civil aircraft, including modified, import, export, military surplus and amateur-built aircraft.

Qualification Requirements:

- ➔ A citizen of the United States with a valid state driver's license and fluent in the English language.
- ➔ Experience in the area of quality control/quality assurance systems, methods and techniques in the manufacture of aircraft, aircraft engines, propellers or major aircraft components that demonstrates the ability to determine that aircraft and related products meet design criteria and are in condition for safe operation; or
- ➔ Experience involving the issuance of original airworthiness certificates or original export airworthiness approvals for aircraft, aircraft engines, propellers, or major aircraft components; or
- ➔ Experience involving a combination of the two above.

Specialized experience may have been acquired in such positions as quality control engineer, quality control/assurance supervisor or manager, quality systems auditor or service representative with technical quality control experience; or as a FAA designee authorized to perform manufacturing inspection functions on behalf of the FAA.
