Professional Positions:

There are a wide variety of professional jobs in the FAA, including human resource management specialists, budget analysts, administrative officers, program analysts, management analysts, logistics specialists and contracting specialists to name a few. These jobs typically use and apply principles and theories of the specialty field and provide essential support to the aviation mission of the agency.

Qualification Requirements:

Qualifications vary, depending on the job level and type of position. A bachelor's degree or three years of general experience is required for entry level positions. Additional education, superior academic achievement and/or specialized experience are required for higher level jobs. You must be a United States citizen.
