Dangerous Goods and Cargo Security Specialist:

A Dangerous Goods and Cargo Security Specialist is responsible for coordinating and performing investigative, inspection and advisory work on hazardous materials cases or portions of hazardous materials cases at designated airports in a geographical area. Special Agents assure the understanding and compliance with federal regulations regarding all aspects of aviation security and the hazardous materials regulations. This is not an ordinary job, but it may be the job for you, if you are interested in protecting the traveling public and providing for the integrity of the civil aviation security system. (Special Agent credentials are received after completion of training.)



Qualification Requirements:

- ➔ Have a bachelor's degree or three years of general experience for entry level positions.
- ➔ Have additional education, superior academic achievement and/or specialized experience for higher level positions.
- ➔ Be a United States citizen.
- ➔ Pass a security background investigation.
