

AIR BOSS IMPLEMENTATION PROCEDURES

On January 1, 2019, the Air Boss phased implementation process will begin as follows:

1. For applicants that have completed the Air Boss Recognition Program prior to March 31, 2019:

a) ICAS will forward the Air Boss LOA recommendation to AFS-830 using the following email address: 9-AFS-800-Correspondence@faa.gov

b) Upon receipt, AFS-830 will evaluate the recommendation and issue the Air Boss LOA accordingly.

2. **Basic Air Boss** applicants that have not received an LOA by March 31, 2019 must follow the following steps:

a) No Later Than March 31, 2019 the applicant must have:

i) Applied on-line

ii) Achieved a satisfactory score on the objective test

3. **Standard Air Boss and Recognized Air Boss/Single Venue/Multiple Venue** applicants that have not received an LOA by March 31, 2019 must follow the following steps:

a) No Later Than March 31, 2019 the applicant must have:

i) Applied on-line

ii) Achieved a satisfactory score on the objective test

iii) Scheduled an evaluation during the 2019 air show season.

4. All U.S. air shows issued a FAA CoW (FAA Form 7711-1) after December 31, 2019 must use an air boss with an FAA-issued Basic Air Boss LoA, Standard Air Boss LoA, Recognized Air Boss LoA/Single Venue or Recognized Air Boss/Multiple Venue as explained in FAA Order 8900.1, Volume 5, Chapter 9, Section 6 and in the ICAS Air Boss Recognition Program Manual.

For the 2019 Season, in order to provide Air Boss services at an Air Show, the assigned Air Boss must have been issued an Air Boss LOA, or completed Steps 2 or 3.
