

905. AIR CARRIER OPERATIONS BULLETIN NO. 8-76-4

APPROVING ITEMS FOR USE IN FIRST-AID KITS

(Formerly Air Carrier Operations Alert No. 75-4).

Amendment 121-115, effective January 1, 1975, and published in the January 6, 1975, Federal Register, changes Part 121, Appendix A, in part, to provide for the use of FAA approved items that are not specified in Federal Specification GG-K-391A in the required first-aid kits.

- a. Although Appendix A specifies, as a minimum, the kind and quantity of items that each first-aid kit must contain, it does not prohibit the use of a kit that contains any of the items specified in quantities exceeding the minimums specified.
- b. The amendment makes the provisions of Appendix A more flexible by permitting FAA approved first-aid items to be substituted for those specified in GG-K-391A.
- c. Prior to approving these items for use in first-aid kits, the FAA inspector shall obtain the written concurrence of the FAA Regional Flight Surgeon or the Office of Aviation Medicine, AAM-1.
