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**ORDER**

Global Systems Technologies, Inc. ("GST") filed these Consolidated Protests with the Federal Aviation Administration's ("FAA") Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"). The Consolidated Protests challenge a decision by the FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center ("Center") to conduct a re-competition for a technical services contract, rather than award the contract to GST following the disqualification of the original awardee. The Protests also challenge the Center's conduct of the re-competition and its ultimate decision to award the contract to another company.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendations, and hereby deny the Consolidated Protests in their entirety.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
