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**ORDER**

Windsor Enterprises ("Protester") has protested the award of weather observation services contracts pursuant to Solicitation DTFA14-98-R-33990. The Protester alleges that the awardee submitted unreasonably low bids for the work involved in the subject contracts and that the FAA Great Lakes Region has failed to make an appropriate bidder responsibility determination in awarding the contracts.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA") and hold that this protest is without any basis whatsoever in fact or law. Accordingly, in accordance with the recommendation of the ODRA made pursuant Section 3.9.3.2.3.3 of the FAA Acquisition Management System, I hereby dismiss the instant protest summarily and with prejudice.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110. A petition for review must be filed with the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, or in the court of appeals of the United States for the circuit in which the petitioner resides or has its principal place of business.
