ORDER

In Case Number, 98-ODRA-00095 (hereinafter the "Original Protest"), Information Systems & Networks Corporation ("ISN") protested its elimination from the competition for a technical, engineering, and management assistance support services contract for a digital aeronautical data link ("ADL") communication system between aircraft and ground systems. By FAA Order Number ODRA-98-100, entered in the Original Protest on December 18, 1998, I required that the Product Team Re-evaluate ISN's proposal and report the results of the Re-evaluation to the ODRA. In the current protest, ISN challenges the ADL Product Team's January 19, 1999 Re-evaluation decision, which again eliminated ISN from the competition for the ADL contract.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"); and deny the Protest on the basis that the Product Team's Re-evaluation decision to eliminate ISN from the competition had a rational basis and was consistent FAA Order Number ODRA-98-100.
