ORDER

Informatica of America, Inc. ("IAI") has protested the award of a contract to Multimax, Inc. ("Multimax") under Solicitation No. DTFA03-99-R-00020 (the "Solicitation") issued by the FAA William J. Hughes Technical Center, Atlantic City, New Jersey (the "Center").

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendation of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA") and hereby sustain the protest and order that the Center immediately terminate the Multimax contract for the Government's convenience and award a contract to IAI for all but tasks 5 and 6 under the Solicitation.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110. A petition for review must be filed with the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit, or in the court of appeals of the United States for the circuit in which the petitioner resides or has its principal place of business.
