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**ORDER**

Solicitation DTFAWA-15-R-00025 sought competitive proposals for a new “Controller Training Contract” to provide and support air traffic controller training. CACI, Inc.-Federal (“CACI”) protests the award to Science Applications International Corporation (“SAIC”). CACI alleges that the Federal Aviation Administration’s Product Team: (1) improperly evaluated labor rates, risk, and best value; (2) improperly evaluated SAIC proposed program management personnel under subfactor 2.1; and (3) permitted a personal conflict of interest to taint the integrity of the acquisition process.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt and incorporate by reference the attached Findings and Recommendation of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”). Accordingly, I hereby deny the Protest in part, but sustain the Protest inasmuch as the Product Team lacked a rational basis for the evaluation under subfactor 2.1. Further, I adopt and order the corrective action recommended by the ODRA.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.43 (2013), within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
