ORDER


CEMSol, LLC (“CEMSol”) filed this Bid Protest (“Protest”) with the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) on April 1, 2016. The Protest challenges the award of a contract to The Boeing Company to provide Central Reporting and Datalink Monitoring Support Services in support of the development of future air navigation systems. The ODRA found that the award decision has a rational basis, is consistent with the FAA’s Acquisition Management System and is supported by substantial evidence in the record.

Pursuant to a Delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator,* I adopt and incorporate herein the attached Findings and Recommendations and deny the Protest in its entirety.

* Final decisional authority over bid protests involving acquisitions valued at not more than twenty million dollars has been delegated to the ODRA Director. *Delegation of Authority of October 12, 2011, as revised March 19, 2014; see also 79 FR 21832 (Apr. 17, 2014).*

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. Any review of this Order shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.43 (2016), within sixty (60) days of service of this Order.
