ORDER

CGH Technologies, Inc. ("CGH") filed a Bid Protest and a Supplemental Protest (collectively, the "Protest") with the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"). The Protest challenges a contract awarded to Concept Solutions, LLC ("Concept") under Solicitation 15-001-CS, issued by the eFAST Program Office ("Program Office"). The Program Office has moved for dismissal with prejudice on the ground that it will take "voluntary and full corrective action." *Motion to Dismiss* at 1. After providing all parties the opportunity to respond, the ODRA overruled CGH's objections and recommended that the Protest be dismissed with prejudice. *Findings and Recommendations* at 2 and 4.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt and incorporate by reference the attached Findings and Recommendation of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"), and hereby dismiss the Protest with prejudice.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the

ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.43 (2016), within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
