MANSFIELD TOWER LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 11-2

SUBJECT: Practice Instrument Approaches

CANCELLATION: December 31, 2012

VFR aircraft practicing instrument approaches to Mansfield-Lahm Airport will be provided standard IFR separation.

Standard IFR separation will be provided to VFR aircraft practicing approaches to all secondary airports under Mansfield Approach Control jurisdiction to the extent possible within existing resources. When the controller is unable to provide separation, the aircraft will be instructed to maintain VFR, and the traffic information will be issued. The airports covered by this paragraph are:

Ashland County
Marion Municipal
Shelby Community

Galion Municipal
Morrow County
Willard

Huron County
Port Bucyrus
Wyandot County

Pilots not on IFR flight plans desiring practice instrument approaches should always state "practice" when making a request to Mansfield Approach. The controller will instruct VFR aircraft requesting an instrument approach to maintain VFR. If a subsequent heading or altitude is assigned that would preclude VFR operation, maintain VFR and advise immediately.

Mansfield Approach Control frequencies are 124.2 and 127.35.

It is recommended that pilots using this service periodically review AIM, paragraph 4-3-21, Practice Instrument Approaches.
