


## Philadelphia District Designated Pilot Examiners (DPE)

Due to the latest changes, information on all Designated Pilot Examiners (DPEs) is now accessible through the Designee Management System (DMS)

To access the DMS:

- Select the DMS link [here](#)
- Review the System Use Notice and select “I agree”;
- In the upper right corner, find “Looking for a Designee in your area?” And select the “Click Here” hot link;
- Select the drop down menu for Designee Type and select “DPE”

If you know the name of a particular DPE, select “Designee Search” and enter the person’s first and last name (see example below)...

If you’re not sure and need a list of DPEs for your area...

- Select the “Location Search” radial button and use the following drop down blocks to narrow your search;
- In the Country search line, select “United States”
- In the State search line, select your state (for example, “Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, etc.)

If you want to narrow your search by City or Postal (Zip) Code, you can enter that information in the blocks.

You may select any, some, or all of the Authorizations you are looking for.
