Inspection Authorization Renewal Notice

Inspection Authorization Holders, at this time you currently have two options for renewing your Inspection Authorization (IA) in accordance with 14 C.F.R. § 65.93 during the month of March 2021.

Option 1: Coming in March 2021 - Renew electronically via FAA's Integrated Airman Certification and Rating Application (IACRA) by visiting <https://iacra.faa.gov/IACRA/Default.aspx>. IACRA is the web-based certification/rating application that guides the user through the FAA's airman application process. When updated, please read the "New User Guide" that is located on the login page of IACRA for more information on creating an account.

Option 2: Mail your IA package to the STL FSDO for the processing of your IA renewal.

Completing the FAA Form 8610-1 certifies the applicant met the requirements of 14 CFR 65.93. Failure to complete these forms and submit a complete package (as outlined below) will result in the application being returned to the applicant without action and may prevent renewal of Inspection Authorization.

- Evidence of completion of activities for renewal in accordance with 14 C.F.R. § 65.93(a)
