The Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) DBE/ACDBE Program Compliance Team is offering free training and technical assistance in the form of practical implementation tools for funding recipients of the FAA. Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Liaison Officers (DBELOs) and other program administrators responsible for implementing the Department of Transportation's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) and Airport Concession DBE (ACDBE) programs are invited to participate in this two and a half-day DBE Academy to better understand program requirements through interactive group sessions, independent assessments, and program reviews. Participants will receive a certificate of completion on the last day of the training.

Participants are encouraged to bring existing DBE program plans, goal methodologies, and laptops. The DBE Academy instructors (FAA staff) and participants will work together to address areas of greatest concern and provide practical and targeted solutions. Instructors will facilitate meaningful dialogue and guidance. Some of the topics to be covered include: *Reporting and Uniform Forms; Good Faith Efforts; Monitoring & Enforcement; Counting and Commercially Useful Function; Utilization; DBE and ACDBE Goal-Setting; and, Common Certification Misunderstandings.*

Participants will leave the DBE Academy inspired and confident in their ability to implement the DBE Program requirements.
