



## **Federal Aviation Administration New England Region**

The FAA New England Regional office buildings are located in Burlington, Massachusetts. Our area of responsibility includes Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island, and Vermont. We provide air traffic control and other aviation services within this six-state region.

### **Driving Directions from Logan Airport to the Regional Office**

Note that this area is under construction. You may experience detours. When leaving airport, bear left on Route C-1. Go about 1/4 mile to Sumner Tunnel, take ramp to expressway north and in less than 1 mile, bear left onto Route I-93 North. Drive about 12 miles to Exit 37B South, onto Route I-95 South (a.k.a. Route 128 South). Travel about 6 miles and take Exit 33B. Coming off ramp, proceed straight through lights. Turn left at the fifth set of lights into the New England Executive Park. The FAA is building #12 on your left. Call (781) 238-7001 if need further assistance.

### **Driving Directions from the Massachusetts Turnpike to the Regional Office**

Take the I-95/Route 128 exit (Exit 14) and merge onto I-95/128 North. Take Route 3 North/Middlesex Turnpike exit (Exit 32B/32A) towards Lowell/Nashua, NH. Keep left at the first fork in the ramp and head towards Middlesex Turnpike. Then move over to the right side and take a right onto the ramp to Middlesex Turnpike. Turn right at the end of the ramp onto the Middlesex Turnpike. Turn right onto Mall Road. Turn right into the New England Executive Park. The FAA is building #12 on your left.

### **Driving Directions from Manchester Airport to the Regional Office**

Start out going East on Bridge Street towards Ash Street by turning left. Turn left to take the I-93 South ramp towards Portsmouth(RT-101)/Salem/Boston. Merge onto I-93 South. Take I-93 South/NH-101 West. Take I-93 South towards Derry/Boston. Merge onto I-93 South. I-93 South becomes I-93 South/Alan B. Shepard JR HWY. I-93 South/Alan B. Shepard Jr. Highway becomes I-93 South. Take the I-95 South/RT-128 South exit (Exit 37B) towards Waltham. Merge onto I-95 South/MA-128 South. Take Exit 33B. Coming off ramp, proceed straight through lights. Turn left at the fifth set of lights into the New England Executive Park. The FAA is building #12 on your left.
