ORDER

On May 15, 2002, Edward B. Block Consulting (“Block”) filed the above protest concerning contracts issued by the Federal Aviation Administration’s Technical Center related to aircraft wiring.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) and hold that Block has no standing to protest and that the ODRA lacks jurisdiction over the subject matter involved. Accordingly, I hereby dismiss the Protest summarily.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought, in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.43, within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Order.
