ORDER

Dynamic Security Concepts, Inc. (“DSCI”) filed a Contract Dispute with the Federal Aviation Administration Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) alleging that the Federal Aviation Administration William J. Hughes Technical Center (“Center”) had breached the duty of good faith and fair dealing in the administration of a technical services contract with DSCI (“Contract”). The Contract, which was awarded on June 1, 2000, and continued through November 30, 2005 was for an indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity of services and included a guaranteed minimum of \$400,000 of work. DSCI was tasked with and completed more than \$14 million of work under the Contract. DSCI contended, however, it was not awarded additional work because of the malice and bad faith of Center personnel.

For the reasons set forth therein, I hereby adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the ODRA and deny the Contract Dispute in its entirety.
