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**ORDER**

Astornet Technologies, Inc. (“Astornet”) filed a bid protest (“Protest”) with the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) challenging the award of task order work to Security First Consulting Services by an FAA Program Office. Pursuant to the Delegation of final decisional authority from the Administrator, dated March 10, 2004, I adopt the attached ODRA Decision and summarily dismiss the Protest for failure to state upon which relief may be granted.\*

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
