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**ORDER**

Technical Innovative Concepts, Inc., (“TIC”) filed this Contract Dispute with the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) on October 9, 2008, challenging the termination for default of Contract DTFACE-08-C-00040. The Central Region of the Federal Aviation Administration (“Region”) asserts the termination for default was proper, and asserts its own claim for damages of \$25,306. Pursuant to the Delegation of final decisional authority from the Administrator, dated March 10, 2004,\* I adopt and incorporate herein the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendations, uphold the termination for default and award the Region \$25,306 in damages against TIC.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.

\*Pursuant to the Delegation, the ODRA Director is authorized to issue final decisions for the FAA Administrator in contract disputes “involving a total amount to be adjudicated... of not more than five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00).”
