ORDER

Aerospace Safety and Security, Inc. ("ASAS") filed this Bid Protest ("Protest") with the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"). The Protest challenges the decision by the FAA to reject an unsolicited proposal from ASAS to enter into a cooperative research and development agreement ("CRDA"). Pursuant to the Delegation of final decisional authority from the Administrator, dated March 31, 2010, I adopt the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendation and dismiss the Protest in its entirety as not within the subject matter jurisdiction of the ODRA*
