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**ORDER**

Northern Building, Inc. (“NBI”) submitted a Contract Dispute to the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) pursuant to a subcontract between it and an FAA prime contractor, Parsons Infrastructure & Technology Group, Inc. (“Parsons”). The Contract Dispute sought payment of the balance of NBI’s subcontract with Parsons in the amount of \$181,261.17 from the FAA Central Service Logistics Area. NBI’s subcontract involved the provision of safety upgrades to Chicago’s Midway Airport.

Pursuant to a delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator,\* I adopt and incorporate herein the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendations, and dismiss the Contract Dispute for lack of subject matter jurisdiction.

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\* Final decisional authority over contract disputes involving a total amount adjudicated of not more than ten million dollars has been delegated to the ODRA Director. See *Delegation of Authority*, dated March 19, 2014.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 (2012) and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.43 (2014), within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
