ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Respondent Ingram Daigs James filed a timely notice of appeal from Acting Chief Administrative Law Judge Ronnie A. Yoder's written order assessing a \$3000 civil penalty issued on May 11, 2001. Ms. James was required to perfect her appeal by filing an appeal brief no later than 55 days after the issuance of that order under 14 C.F.R. §§ 13.233(c) and 13.211(e).

Ms. James has neither filed an appeal brief nor requested an extension of time in which to file an appeal brief. Accordingly, Ms. James' appeal is subject to dismissal under 14 C.F.R. § 13.233(d)(2).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Respondent's appeal is dismissed.
