**ORDER**

IBEX Group, Inc. (“IBEX”) filed the instant Protest (“Protest”) challenging a re-evaluation mandated in an FAA Administrator’s Order dated May 2, 2003 (“Order”). The Order had been issued based on Findings and Recommendations by the FAA Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) in *Consolidated Protests of Consecutive Weather, Eye Weather, Windsor Enterprises and IBEX Group, Inc.*, ODRA Docket Numbers 02-ODRA-00250, 00251, 00252, and 00254. In Docket Number 02-ODRA-00254, IBEX had protested the award of weather observation services contracts by the FAA Headquarters Air Traffic Planning and Procedures, Contract Weather Observer (“CWO”) Program Office Product Team (“Product Team”) under Solicitation DTFA01-02-R-031130 (“the Solicitation”).

The Solicitation involved the procurement of CWO services at four groupings of airports (“Site Groups”). The Order directed that, among other things, the Product Team re-evaluate IBEX’s proposals in accordance with the ODRA’s Findings and Recommendations and determine whether IBEX would be entitled to an award of Site Groups 13, 14, or 15.
