DCT Incorporated (“DCT”) filed a contract dispute with the FAA Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) seeking a price adjustment in the amount of \$115,365.60 under the above-referenced Contract with the FAA Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center. Pursuant to the Delegation of final decisional authority from the Administrator, dated March 10, 2004, I adopt the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendation, and direct the Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center to make payment of the full amount requested plus applicable interest.*
