ORDER

Optical Scientific, Incorporated (“OSI”) filed this Protest with the Federal Aviation Administration’s (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) in which it challenged a reevaluation conducted by the FAA Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center’s (“the Center”) that resulted in the selection of Vaisala, Incorporated (“Vaisala”) for the award of an indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contract for Automated Weather Observation System Visibility Sensors. The reevaluation had been ordered based on the sustaining of OSI’s earlier protest to the ODRA in Case Number 06-ODRA-00365.

Pursuant to the Delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the ODRA and dismiss the Protest in part and deny the remainder of the Protest.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
