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**ORDER**

MCRB Service Bureau, Inc. (“MCRB”) filed the instant Protest (“Protest”) challenging the decision by the Federal Aviation Administration’s (“FAA”) National Aeronautical Charting Group Program Office (“Program Office”) to procure warehousing, archiving and distribution services for aeronautical charts and products from Parsons Infrastructure and Technology Group (“Parsons”), pursuant to a Work Release issued under the FAA’s existing Technical Support Services Contract (“TSSC”). MCRB contends that the required services fall outside the scope of the TSSC, and that the Program Office was required to procure these services via a competitive small business set-aside.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached Odra Findings and Recommendations, and hereby deny the Protest in its entirety.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
