ORDER

The Dayton Group, Inc. ("TDG") filed this Protest with the Federal Aviation Administration's ("FAA") Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"). The TDG Protest challenges an evaluation conducted by the FAA Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center ("Center") for the award of an indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contract for support service related to the establishment of a Program Management Office. TDG's Protest claims that the Center's evaluators had misinterpreted TDG's price proposal and had not properly scored TDG's technical proposal.

Pursuant to the Delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the ODRA and deny the Protest in its entirety.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
