ORDER

Condor Reliability Services, Inc. ("Condor") has submitted a contract dispute under Contract No. DTFA04-00-C-20017 issued by the FAA Alaska Region ("Region") for weather observation services for two locations in Alaska. The dispute sought an equitable adjustment of the contract price in the amount of \$16,286.00.

For the reasons set forth in the attached Findings and Recommendations of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition ("ODRA"), and pursuant to the March 27, 2000 Delegation of final decisional authority from the Administrator to the Director of the ODRA*, it is ordered that the contract dispute be and hereby is dismissed summarily, pursuant to 14 C.F.R. §17.29(a)(3), for failure to state a matter upon which relief may be granted.

* The March 27, 2000 Delegation grants the Associate Chief Counsel/Director of the ODRA "authority to execute and issue on behalf of the Administrator, orders and final decisions for the FAA in all matters within the ODRA's jurisdiction, provided that such matters involve...a contract dispute involving a total amount in dispute, exclusive of interest, legal fees or costs, of not more than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00)." See Federal Register Vol. 65, No. 72, at p. 19958, April 13, 2000.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.43, within sixty (60) days of the issuance of this Order.
