ORDER

On December 18, 1998, the FAA Administrator issued Order No. ODRA-98-100 sustaining the protest of Information Systems & Networks corporation ("ISN") and directing the Product Team to re-evaluate ISN's past cost performance in a manner consistent with the ODRA's Findings and Recommendations. The ODRA recommended that the evaluation team reconsider its past cost performance evaluation of ISN by determining (1) whether its timekeeping system deficiency had been adequately corrected to the Team's satisfaction, and (2) whether or not corrected, such a deficiency continued to pose a "risk of performance failure" within the meaning of the SIR evaluation criteria for past cost performance for the ADL Contract. The Product Team was to report the results of its re-evaluation to the ODRA.

As directed by the Administrator, the Product Team submitted to the ODRA its re-evaluation report ("Report") on January 19, 1999. In the Report, the Product Team reconsidered its past cost performance evaluation of ISN and eliminated ISN from the competition on the basis that its "timekeeping system deficiencies continue to pose an unacceptable risk of performance failure." See Report at Exhibit B, page 1. The Product Team Report also stated that "ISN was appropriately excluded from the competition on
