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**ORDER**

Siemens Building Technologies, Inc. ("Protester") protested awards under Solicitation Nos. DTFA06-99-R-50006 (Raleigh-Durham Airport) and DTFA06-99-R-50005 (Tampa Airport) (the "Solicitations") issued by the Southern Region for Air Traffic Control Tower fire protection and life safety modifications, including new fire alarm systems. The Protester alleges that the subcontractor proposed by the awardee does not meet the minimum qualifications set forth in the project specifications, and thus was improperly approved by the Southern Region.

For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition and dismiss the consolidated protests summarily and with prejudice pursuant to Section 3.9.3.2.3.3 of the FAA Acquisition Management System.
