ORDER

Diamond Antenna and Microwave Corporation filed these Bid Protests with the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”). The Protests challenge the FAA Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center’s announced intent to award a contract on a single source basis to Kevlin Corporation for 13 rotary joint L-Band Beacons and 13 rotary joint L-Band Receivers as used in the Agency’s Air Route Surveillance Radars (“ARSR-4”).

Pursuant to a Delegation of final decisional authority from the FAA Administrator, I adopt and incorporate herein the attached ODRA Findings and Recommendations, hereby sustain the Protest, and direct the Center to take corrective action consistent with this Order.*

* Final decisional authority over bid protests involving acquisitions valued at not more than ten million dollars has been delegated to the ODRA Director. *See* Delegation of Authority, dated October 12, 2011.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. Any review of this Order shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. §17.43 (2012), within sixty (60) days of service of this Order.
