ORDER

Protester, Royalea'L Aviation Consultants ("Royalea'L") filed an initial protest ("Initial Protest") alleging that the FAA Aeronautical Center ("Center") failed to conduct a competition for training services, improperly extending the contract of the incumbent in lieu of such a competition. Following the filing of the Protest, the Center voluntarily took corrective action and conducted a competition. At the conclusion of the competition, Royalea'L, which was not the successful bidder in the competition, filed a subsequent protest docketed as Odra Case No. 04-ODRA-00304 ("Subsequent Protest").

Royalea'L was provided an opportunity to file a Memorandum of Authorities in support of any objection to the dismissal of the Initial Protest as moot. Royalea'L failed to provide any such Memorandum within the time specified, or thereafter. Rather, Royalea'L indicated it would not object to the dismissal.

The ODRA finds the Initial Protest moot, and it therefore is dismissed. The ODRA further finds that allegations of fact underlying the Initial Protest may be relevant to the Royalea'L Subsequent Protest. It is further ordered that the facts alleged in the Initial Protest are incorporated in the record of the Royalea'L Subsequent Protest.
