ORDER

Caribe Electronics, Ltd., Inc. (“Caribe”) filed this Protest with the Federal Aviation Administration’s (“FAA”) Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition (“ODRA”) in which it challenged the unrestricted status of a Solicitation that was issued by the FAA Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center’s (“the Center”) for Food, Central Desk Management, and Maid & Linen services required by the FAA’s Center for Management and Executive Leadership (“CMEL”) located in Palm Coast, Florida. Caribe also challenged the consolidation—or “bundling”—of these three services into one acquisition.

For the reasons set forth therein, I hereby adopt the attached Findings and Recommendations of the ODRA and deny the Protest in its entirety.

This is the final Agency order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
