ORDER

Systems Research and Applications Corporation (“SRA”) protested the award to Lockheed Martin Corporation of a Contract under Solicitation No. DTFawa-09-R-05084 (“Solicitation”). The Contract is for Integration Support Services for NAS modernization programs and projects. The support services to be provided include, among other things, implementation and integration support, strategic and operational planning support, engineering support and environmental support. The Contract requires the provision of all services and personnel, and related management, administration, facilities, and equipment necessary to support FAA operations in these areas.

The SRA Protest raised multiple grounds challenging the conduct of the evaluation and award process, the scoring of proposals and the relative treatment of offerors. For the reasons set forth therein, I adopt and incorporate by reference the attached Findings and Recommendation of the Office of Dispute Resolution for Acquisition, and hereby deny the Protest in its entirety.

This is the final Agency Order in this matter. To the extent that this decision is subject to review, such review shall be sought in accordance with 49 U.S.C. § 46110 and the ODRA Procedural Rule, 14 C.F.R. § 17.33, within sixty (60) days of issuance of this Order.
