


# COE Teaming

- **Only U.S. Institutes of Higher Education (Public and Private Colleges and Universities) are eligible for core membership on a COE Team**
  - A foreign university having an agreement in place with a core member may be considered as an affiliate to an FAA COE in order to facilitate coordinated efforts between the foreign institution and our COE team. The cost or value of the research and COE related efforts that might be conducted by a foreign university to augment the COE's research agenda would serve as matching contributions.
- **COE Team Members should be in Geographically Equitable Locations**
- **Industry and Other Affiliates may be added as appropriate**




# UAS COE Management & Coordination



If a team of universities is selected as the UAS COE, serves as the lead to manage center.


# UAS COE Funding Structure

- **COE Grants** to benefit the UAS Community (Public Purpose) - require 1:1 match mandated by Congress
- **Contracts to benefit the FAA PMO** - authorized by the White House Reinvention Lab (*1 Year beyond award*)
